2D artwork must be hung by a single wire system. Sawtooth hangers and D-rings will not be accepted hanging techniques.

3D works need to provide their own pedestal (black or white only).

Artists, and their volunteers, are responsible for installing and deinstalling the work. NRH Cultural Arts Coordinator will be available for assistance.

Installation: Monday, March 3 from 12pm-4pm. Reception: Thursday, April 17 from 3pm-5pm. Deinstallation: Friday, April 18 from 11am-3pm.
